## Saksoft net up

Chennai, Nov 5:

Saksoft Limited, a software services company with focus on banking and financial Services (BFS) segment, has posted a net profit of Rs 245 lakh for the quarter ended 30 September, up by 49 per cent from the corresponding quarter last year. The Q2 sales was also higher by 50 per cent at Rs 1,241.87 lakh, compared to the previous year. With this performance, the total sales in the first half (April- September) touched Rs 2,335.68 lakh, a 49 per cent growth over the sales for the same period last year and the net profit was also up 49 per cent at Rs 457.28 lakh.
